Standard First Aid provides comprehensive training covering all aspects of first aid and CPR. Standard First Aid incorporates all of Emergency First Aid and is designed for those who require a more in-depth understanding of first aid including legal implications of first aid treatment, spinal injuries, heat or cold injuries, bone and joint injuries, chest injuries, and medical emergencies. Includes CPR-C certification.

The first aid program is not restricted to aquatic candidates. You can use the Life-saving Society's first aid awards to trained non-aquatic staff (camp, playground, maintenance, etc.) and the general public.

Current First Aid Instructors teach Standard First Aid, but only current First Aid Examiners may certify candidates. Life-saving Society Standard First Aid certification is valid for 36 months from the certification date.
